Pre-Operative Testing Guidelines - Other	
Chest X-Ray	Patient has signs or symptoms suggesting new or unstable cardiopulmonary disease.
Coagulation Studies	Patient has a known history of coagulation abnormalities or recent history suggesting coagulation problems or is on anticoagulants.  Patient needs anticoagulation postoperatively (where a baseline may be needed.
Hemoglobin	Patient has a history of anemia or history suggesting recent blood loss or anemia.
Potassium	Patient is taking one or more of the following: <ul><li>Digoxin</li><li>Diurectics</li><li>ACE inhibitors</li><li>Angiotension Receptor Blockers</li></ul>
Pregnancy Test	<ul> <li>Patient is of child-bearing age and:</li> <li>Is sexually active and history suggest possible pregnancy, e.t. delayed menstruation</li> <li>Patient is concerned about possible pregnancy</li> <li>Possibility of pregnancy is uncertain</li> </ul>
